The Northern Netherlands: Transformation of a gasproducing region into a forerunner in the biobased circular transition

The Northern Netherlands and North-West of Germany are both agricultural regions and aim to play a leading role in the biobased/circular transition. Within this workshop André Heeres (Hanze University of Applied Sciences, Groningen) will present recent developments of the transformation of the chemical industry in the Dutch region. 3N Center of Experts will present contributions to circular economy.

The Interreg VIa projects Realise-Bio lead by Cluster industrial Biotechnology and EMPHATI will present open project approaches that provide input for circular economy.

The contribution will outline the ingredients necessary to achieve the above-described (green energy, renewable feedstocks, knowledge, and infrastructure) and how this could also be relevant for the neighboring German - Dutch region. 


